Betty Colavecchi (nee Hoaglund), 87, of Kingsford, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, June 19, 2019 at Freeman Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Kingsford. She was born on March 23, 1932 in Homestead, WI, daughter of the late Herbert and Esther (Anderson) Hoaglund. She graduated from Kingsford High School in 1950. Betty moved to Milwaukee, WI and Chicago, IL and then settled in the Iron Mountain-Kingsford area, where she worked for many years for Dr. Alfred Miller in his dental practice. Upon marriage, she moved with her husband and family to the Way Dam Reservoir, where her husband Biaggio worked for Wisconsin Electric Power Company.

Betty enjoyed the company of family and friends, entertaining, pets and animal causes and gardening.
