Bill Andrew Wiegele, 84, of Iron Mountain, passed away on Monday, August 9, 2021 at Dickinson County Healthcare System.

Bill was born November 30, 1936, in Iron Mountain, son of the late Louis and Agnes (Mortl) Wiegele. He graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1955 and was a lifelong resident of the area.
