Eugene N Gendron, 90, of Norway, died Sunday, Dec. 24, 2107 at Freeman Nursing and Rehabilitation Community. He was born on Oct. 11, 1927, in Norway, the son of the late Patrick and Stella (LaVigne) Gendron. He was one of 11 children and raised in Norway.
