Gerald E. "Jerry" Wickman, 91, of Iron Mountain, passed away on Wednesday, November 29, 2017 in Billings, MT.

Jerry was born March 1, 1926 in Iron Mountain, son of the late Edward and Minnie (Dixon) Wickman. He graduated from Felch High School in 1944 and was a lifelong resident of the area. Jerry worked for the Ford Motor Co. in Kingsford for several years following his graduation. He married Carol J. Mattson on November 22, 1952. She preceded him in death on September 1, 2001. Jerry was employed by Grede Foundry where he worked in the shipping department for over 30 years, retiring in 1988. He married Teresa Pummill on July 29, 2006 in Iron Mountain. Jerry was a member of First Lutheran Church in Iron Mountain and the Eastern Dickinson County Sportsmen's Club. He was an avid outdoorsman and loved hunting and fishing, especially trout fishing the streams which he continued to do until age 89. He also enjoyed traveling and most of all loved spending time with family and friends.
