Patrick Charles Moreau, 75, of 1316 Wilson St. Niagara, died Friday April 30, 2010, at ManorCare HCR in Kingsford. He was born Dec. 28, 1934, in Niagara, son of the late Gilbert and Clara (Veesser) Moreau.
