NORWAY - Adelaide Marie Bottesi, 97, of Norway, died Wednesday, May 27, 2009, at Pinecrest Medical Care Facility in Powers.

Adelaide was born Feb. 27, 1912, in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late George and Amanda (Thibeault) DesMarais. She attended Iron Mountain High School and was a lifelong resident of the area.
