Agatha Ann “Aggie” (Andrick) Cavaiani, 94, of Kingsford, passed away on Sunday, October 2, 2022, at U.P. Health System in Marquette.

Aggie was born February 7, 1928 in Kingsford, daughter of the late William and Anna (Lorbeski) Andrick. She graduated from Kingsford High School in 1945 and went to Washington D.C. where she worked for the government for two years.
