



## Agnes Roell

January 21, 1915 - November 8, 2006

CHANNING - Agnes M. Roell, 91, formerly of Channing, died Wednesday, Nov. 8, 2006, at Hyland Nursing Home in Iron Mountain, surrounded by her family.
