Al Sutherland, 91, of Upper Pine Creek, died Sun. May 10, 2015 at the Oscar G. Johnson VA Medical Center. He was born on March 26, 1924 in Pine Creek, the son of the late Simpson and Esther (Norgren) Sutherland.

Al served in the U.S. Army during World War II in the European Theater. He worked as a welder at American Motor Company in Milwaukee.

He married Arvella Lucas on June 28, 1947 in Milwaukee. The couple lived in Oak Creek, WI for many years, before moving to Upper Pine Creek in 1985. She preceded him in death on Nov. 16, 1996.

Al was a member of Quinnesec United Methodist Church. He enjoyed going to rummage sales with his brother Joe, four wheeling, woodworking, building things, working on equipment, hunting, going to the casino, and dancing.

He is survived by five children Lynn (David) Marszalek of Kissimmee, FL, LaVon (Bill) Petroski of Dousman, WI, Lorna (Bob) Rodgers of Iron Mountain, Roger (Kelly) Sutherland of Franklin, WI, and Ted (Tina) Sutherland of Upper Pine Creek, fourteen grandchildren, 18 great grandchildren, a special friend Gloria Vernon, and many nieces and nephews.

Al was preceded in death by three brothers Joe, Walter, and Elmer Sutherland; and three sisters Margie Nielson, Violet DeClark, and Eva Sutherland.
