IRON MOUNTAIN - Alfred G. Picucci, 92, of Iron Mountain, died Sunday, Dec. 28, 2008, at ManorCare Health Services in Kingsford.

He was born March 28, 1916, in Iron Mountain, son of the late Carmen and Mattie (Caduti) Picucci.

Alfred was a lifelong resident of Iron Mountain and he graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1934. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II.

Alfred married Alice Ruffatto on June 14, 1941, at Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Iron Mountain. She preceded him in death on March 1, 2002.

Alfred was a mail carrier and postal supervisor for the U.S. Postal Service for 36 years, retiring in 1973. He was a member of St. Mary and St. Joseph Catholic Church, the Knights of Columbus, and Pine Grove Country Club, where he enjoyed golfing.

He is survived by two sons, David (Mary) Picucci of Brighton, Mich. and James (Gloria) Picucci of Greendale, Wis.; three grandchildren Michael, Stephen, and Jennifer Picucci; one great-granddaughter, Sofia Picucci; and

three nephews and two nieces.

Alfred was preceded in death by two brothers, Attilio and Antonio Picucci, and two sisters, Florence and Marietta.
