May 17, 1946 - June 29, 2023

Devoted wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother, sister, daughter, and friend, died Thursday after a fall at home and a battle with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD). The retired office manager and homemaker was 77.
