Allan Alexander Galeazzi, beloved husband, father, grandfather, and great grandfather passed away on March 1, 2022, at the age of 90. Allan was born to the late Alexander and Marion (Caron) Galeazzi on February 2, 1932.

Allan graduated from Kingsford High School in 1950 and enlisted in the United States Navy. Allan served on the USS Charles R Ware DD865 during the Korean War and was honorably discharged after four years of service. He married Phyllis Edlund on November 19, 1952 in Norway, MI. She preceded him in death in 2020 after 67 years of marriage.

Allan and his wife Phyllis traveled across the country until they settled their roots in Simi Valley, CA. He and Phyllis would take many camping trips to Sequoia National Park, were members of the Golden K, loved dancing in the kitchen and most importantly, they enjoyed spending time with each other.
