Allen B. Muelling, 88, of Iron Mountain, went home to be with the Lord on Mon. March 28, 2011. He was born on Oct. 17, 1922 in Phillips, WI, the son of the late Levi and Lillian (Christensen) Muelling. He was the oldest of thirteen children.

Allen graduated from Phillips High School and attended a business school in Milwaukee, where he studied accounting. He served in the U.S. Army Air Corps from 1943-1946 as a radio operator.

Allen was a talented carpenter and co-owned Muelling Brothers Construction with his brother. He lived in Milwaukee for many years, moving to this area in 1986. On June 8, 1994 he married Lucille Pavlat Antonini in Niagara.

He was a hard worker and was a talented woodworker. Allen also had a strong faith and was passionate about sharing God's truth and love with other people, leaving this quote with those he met: "If we meet and you forget me, you have lost nothing, but if you meet JESUS CHRIST and forget HIM, you have lost everything."

He enjoyed bible study and reading. Allen will also be remembered for his sense of humor.

He is survived by his wife Lucille, three daughters Mary Lee (Gary) Garbe of Richland Center, WI, Nina (Kevin) Graff of Niagara, and Dawn (Bill) Bauer of Madison, one son-in-law Dan Witz of Sun Prairie, WI, three step daughters Susan Ballard of Ypsilanti, Sally (Richard) Otto of Kalkaska, MI and Kathryn (Richard) Bohms of Belleville, MI, twelve grandchildren and thirteen great grandchildren.

Allen was preceded in death by a daughter Joretta Witz and his first wife Rita Muelling.
