Alma A. "Dolly" Ludlow, 79, of Kingsford passed away Tuesday, August 3, 2021, at Dickinson County Healthcare System in Iron Mountain after a short battle with cancer and other medical issues.

Dolly was born October 1, 1941, the daughter of Ad and Edith Maguire and raised in the Fletcher, Oklahoma area.

She married William Ludlow, originally from Ironwood, MI, on July 12, 1960, upon his discharge from Fort Sill, OK, and resided in Michigan throughout her life.
