NIAGARA, Wis. - On Wednesday, June 17, 2009, Angelo Raymond Romitti entered eternal life and peace in the loving arms of His Heavenly Father.

Angelo was born on Dec. 19, 1988, and was 20 years old at the time of his death. His passing is greatly grieved and he will be missed very much by all who loved him.

Angelo loved being outdoors, especially in the winter time and one of the things he enjoyed most was snowboarding with his brother Mario. One of his fondest memories was of the good time he had visiting his brother in Alaska with his mother. Angelo loved going off by himself to fish and thought the world of his dogs. He had many a good time riding four wheelers and doing tricks on his dirt bike.

For several years he played the guitar, which he was good at and also did write one special song. Angelo really cared about children and was always good to the little kids. He enjoyed watching them play and would often ask what was going on in their lives.

Angelo had a smile that could light up the whole day. His smile touched the people he worked with and also the customers he took care of as he loaded their truck or trailer. His skills as a heavy equipment operator were well

beyond his age and he was at peace when he was in his loader.

He had a big heart and talked about wanting to help people who were alone. It was one of his biggest prayers and hope that somehow those who suffered from mental illness could get the help they needed. It took great courage and strength on a daily basis for him to figure out and accomplish everyday normal tasks.

Every day was like climbing a mountain, a struggle without the tools or knowledge of a mountain climber. Through Angelo's passing, it is our hope others can become more aware of the severe impact mental illness can have.

He was so loved by his family and he will be so missed, but we firmly believe he has finally reached the top of the mountain. With that big bright smile and arms open wide he will be waiting for all his loved ones when we are called home too.

“ TRIBUTE TO ANGELO?.MAY HE REST IN PEACE.

I met Angelo Romitti for the first time nearly 6 months ago. He had taken a job delivering newspapers for The Daily News. The route assigned to him had lots of responsibilities as it is one of our more demanding routes. Six days a week he would be required to make deliveries to stores, vending machines and to more than 200 customers throughout city and rural Iron Mountain. He would need to travel hundreds of miles, face all types of inclement weather and manage his time wisely. I admit considering all the demands placed upon him that I was more than a little concerned with his young age of only 20. However, Angelo quickly dismissed my concerns and I am proud to report that Angelo not only did a good job, he did a GREAT job.

Angelo took on all the duties of his new role with eagerness and determination. He learned his route faster than most and took tremendous pride in providing exceptional service. On numerous occasions he volunteered to help others during emergencies. Whenever Angelo was given new instructions he listened intently and he never complained. He did exactly what he was told to do -- he was very obedient. Angelo could always be found going above and beyond never asking for special consideration or compensation. Angelo's dedication to service and strong sense of integrity proved my initial judgments to be premature. I am certain that I was not the first nor last to underestimate Angelo, especially now.

During the short time that I came to know Angelo he proved to me that he was extremely responsible and much more mature than others his age. I had no idea that his presence in my life would be so short-lived. I now know that his presence was a pure treat and a gift from God.

I will forever miss Angelo's boyish grin, the twinkle in his eyes, his adorable laugh, and the way he lit up the room every time he entered. I will miss his curiosity and his innocence. I will miss miss

honesty, his charisma and the way he stood tall when he walked. Did he walk or did he float? He seemed to do both. Angelo had an aura about him that's hard to describe. You couldn't really appreciate it until you experienced it for yourself. Angelo was truly one-of-a-kind. Angelo was a kind and gentle soul. He was always willing to give to those who needed help never asking for anything in return. He had so many more wonderful qualities. He reminded me of my own son.

I will always remember the last day I saw Angelo. It was June 2nd 2009. He came to my office where we visited for a bit. He told me how he loved to cook and how he wanted to go to school to become a chef. Angelo had a sense of determination and drive that made me believe that one day his dream would come true. He always had a positive attitude along with a strong belief in himself. I am deeply saddened at the turn of events which now prevent him from realizing his dreams. He had a promising future ahead of him.

I never talked to Angelo again after that day. I don't know what events occurred during the last two weeks of his life that would have caused his dreams to be shattered and his life to be in such despair. It is an absolute travesty that such a beautiful child should be forced to leave this world before being able to chase his dreams. I have no doubt that he would have become a terrific chef had he been given the chance.

Rest in peace Angel-o. You were (and will always be) an absolute delight! You will be missed by many and deeply missed more than you will ever know.
