



## Ann Luckow

Ann Louise Luckow, 76, of Iron Mountain, passed away unexpectedly on Monday, July 9, 2012 at the Dickinson County Healthcare System in Iron Mountain. She was born on December 13, 1935 in Stambaugh, MI daughter of the late Antone and Olga (Todey) Bicigo. She attended the Crystal Falls schools graduating from Crystal Falls High School in 1955. Ann married Virgil Luckow on November 12, 1955 in Foster City, Michigan.
