After a long and fruitful life, Anna M Ericson died on Christmas day December 25, 2015. She was born July 15, 1918 in Warsaw, New York. Daughter of Joseph Saggese and Lucia (Panzica) Saggese. She graduated from Warsaw High school and then received her Registered Nurse degree from Rochester General Hospital, NY. She worked as an RN at Rochester General from 1941-44. Anna then served her country from 1944 to 1946 in the US Navy as a Lt. RN.

Anna married Robert F Ericson Lt. US Marine Corps on April 6, 1946 in Williamsburg, Virginia. They moved to Iron Mountain MI in May 1946.

Anna started working as a nurse in the newly opened VA hospital in 1950 and retired in 1980 as night supervisor of nursing. She was a member of the ANA, GTWC, the Cancer Society, NARF, the Hospital League, and many other organizations. She was a member of St. Mary and St. Joseph Church since moving to IM. Anna was also involved and an avid supporter of the Carmelite Monastery. She had many hobbies including ceramics and a wide variety of

arts and crafts.

She is survived by four sons Robert of Waukesha WI, , Franklyn (Lyn) of Brookfield WI, Kenneth of Houston Texas and William (Vicky) of Brookfield, WI.
