Anna M. Krenn Turppa, 96, of Niagara, died Sat. Sept. 1, 2012. She was born on Sept. 13, 1915 in Quinnesec, the daughter of the late Martha (Marks) and John Krenn, Sr.

Anna was a longtime resident of Niagara. She worked as a cook at the Kimberly-Clark cafeteria and as a waitress and cook at the Niagara Clubhouse.
