



## Anne Petrus

June 20, 1914 - October 19, 2010

Anne Petrus, 96 years old, of Iron Mountain, transitioned on Tuesday, October 19, 2010, while in the loving care of the nurses and CNAs at Hyland Nursing Home.

Anne was born on June 20, 1914 in Iron Mountain, the daughter of Lawrence and Adeline (Stefanelli) Quadrani. She graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1932 and was accepted into the nursing program at St. Anthony's Hospital in Chicago. She graduated as a registered nurse in 1935 and worked at St. Anthony's until 1942. She married George Petrus (from Cicero, IL) in 1941, and they moved the next year to Two Rivers, WI, and raised three children. In 1969, they went back to the Chicago area (Wilmette) and lived there until 1983, when they decided to spend their retirement years in Anne's beloved hometown, Iron Mountain.

Anne is survived by her son, Greg; her brother, Anthony Quadrani; and two sisters, Marge Frankini and Eleanor Sovey, all of whom reside in the Iron Mountain-Kingsford area; and many nieces and nephews. Anne was preceded in death by her daughter, Patricia (1962); her husband, George (1995); her son, Ralph (2001); and three sisters, Rosemary Quadrani, Jeanette Butsic and Angela Muzzy.
