



Antonette "Dolly" Woempner

September 14, 1923 - June 4, 2013

Antonette "Dolly" Woempner, 89, of Kingsford, died peacefully at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital on Tuesday, June 4, 2013 surrounded by the love of her family and friends.

She was born September 14, 1923, daughter of the late William and Jennie (Gerone) Talerico of Caspian. She graduated from Stambaugh High School in 1940 and on June 14th of that same year, married Calvin Woempner of Iron River. Dolly worked at various jobs in the area and for a short while, in Annapolis, Maryland. But her greatest joy and accomplishment was as a wife, mother and grandmother. Her legacy of love for her family and friends will be remembered by all who knew her and will continue to be a source of comfort for years to come.
