Arlene Frances Flom, 95, of Kingsford passed away Thursday, March 18, 2021, at Evergreen Assisted Living in Kingsford.

Arlene was born in Iron Mountain on July 20, 1925, daughter of Arthur and Alice (Haley) Flom. She graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1942 and from the University of Michigan in 1948.

Her career as an administrative assistant took her to various library, church and business offices, mostly in the Chicago area. She retired from Blue Cross and Blue Shield Association in Chicago, and in 1999 she returned to Iron Mountain to live in the family house. She was a member of Our Saviour's Lutheran Church.
