Arlyce M. Munday, 90, of East Kingsford, passed away peacefully at Freeman Nursing and Rehabilitation Community in Kingsford.

Arlyce was born on May 6, 1929 in Bear Creek, WI and was the daughter of the late Perl and Loretta (Oneska) Behnke. 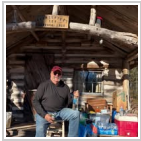
