AURORA, Wis. - August George Heirman, 95, formerly of Aurora and of Evergreen Assisted Living, died Thursday, March 25, 2004, at ManorCare Health Services in Kingsford.

He was born on May 20, 1908, in Norway, son of the late Henry and Florentine (Gyselinck) Heirman.

He and his family moved to Chicago in 1916, and that was where he was raised. He married Mary (Marie) Kuchan on Oct. 31, 1936, in Chicago, and she preceded him in death after 40 years of marriage.
