Barry M. Cohodes, 62, of Kingsford, passed away on June 17, 2010 at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Madison, WI.

He was born September 12, 1947 in Chicago, IL the son of Philip Cohodes and the late Dora (Dwoskin) Cohodes. Barry graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1965 and was a lifelong resident of the area. He was a U. S. Navy veteran. He worked for Florence County as a deputy sheriff for several years and retired in 1982. Barry married Cheryl Warmuth on November 22, 1991 in Iron Mountain. He was a member of the Uren-Cooper-Johnson American Legion Post 50, the International Arabian Horse Association, and the Wisconsin Desert Horse Association. Barry loved his dogs and had a passion for horses.
