Becky M. Harms, 41, of Norway, died unexpectedly at her home on Monday, May 16, 2011, following many years with health issues.

She was born on July 16, 1969, in Iron Mountain, daughter of Ronald and Nancy (Dabb) Hulce. She grew up in Kingsford and Norway, graduating from the Norway High School in 1988.

She married Matthew A. Harms on Dec. 16, 1998, in San Diego, Calif., and had spent 12 wonderful years together.

Becky's love for her husband and kids were only surpassed by her love for the Lord. Her one desire is for her friends, family and others she knew to join her in heaven someday. She was a member of the family of First Baptist Church of Norway. Her children were very precious to her and in recent years have been a big help to her as well. Her husband, Matt, was the love of her life and when she spoke of him you could see her face light up.

She loved horses and over the years has taught others to ride. She worked with the "PEP" group and enjoyed helping others less fortunate to enjoy the sport as much as she did. She was also a longtime member of 4-H clubs and rode in many parades and at local rodeos. She loved to cook and was very talented at it. In recent years, she had found a love in jewelry making as well.

Over the past six years, Becky had many health problems and had traveled across the country for treatment. She made friends everywhere she went and helped look after those that had similar struggles. She was always "mothering" others.

Becky is survived by her husband, Matthew Harms of Norway; three children, Danielle, Alycia, and Ronald, all at home; parents, Ronald and Nancy Hulce of Norway; mother and father in-law, Maryann and Gerhard Harms of San Marcos, Calif.; five brothers, David (Wendy) Hulce of DePere, Wis., Daniel Hulce of Norway, Dale Hulce of Appleton, Wis., Dean (Linda) Hulce of Vulcan, and Daryl Hulce of Davie, Fla.; brothers-in-law and sisters in-law, Gloria, Mark, Marcia (Keith), Glen (Dianne), and Gena (Michael) and Joyce Oleksy of Norway; and many aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, and cousins

Visitation is scheduled for Friday from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. at the Evangelical Covenant Church in Norway.

The funeral service will follow Friday at 4 p.m. at the church. Rev. Andrew Filizetti will officiate.

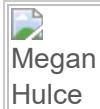
