Benjamin "Ben" Frank Rossi passed away peacefully at his home Tuesday, March 29, 2022, in Milwaukee, WI.

Ben was born in Crystal Falls, MI, November 14, 1954, to Eli and Marilyn (Leanna) Rossi. Being the first grandchild of Irene 'Nona' Rossi, he had a celebrated arrival at Rossi' Bar in Amasa as it was deer season eve and the bar was one of the main gathering spots for hunters in the bustling village.
