KINGSFORD - Bernard J. Gasior, 87 of Kingsford, died on Thursday, Oct. 8, 2009, at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital in Iron Mountain.

He was born on May 17, 1922, in Cudahy, Wis., son of the late Jacob and Mary (Halida) Gasior. He graduated high school and then enlisted in the United States Army on Dec. 10, 1942, serving during World War II. He served in the Italian Campaign and was wounded on Sept. 30, 1944, for which he received the EAME Theatre Ribbon, the Purple Heart, an Oak Leaf Cluster, and two Bronze Battle Stars.

He was a lifelong resident of the Upper Peninsula, and he loved to fish.

Bernard is survived by brothers and sisters, Emil and Del Gasior, Eugene and Mickie Gasior, Irene and Robert Lewandowski, and Alice and Roman Buczkowski; nieces and nephews; and dear friends, Ann Broullire and Sandy Haustein.

The funeral service was held on Saturday, Oct. 10, at the Erickson-Rochon & Nash Funeral Home in Iron Mountain.

Burial was held in the Veterans section at Quinnesec Cemetery. Fr. Joseph Gouin officiated.
