Betty Jean Person, 85, went to be with her Lord and Savior on Wednesday, October 19, 2011, at Hyland Nursing Home in Iron Mountain. She was born September 11, 1926, daughter of the late Paul and Huldah (Johnson) Person and was a 1944 graduate of Iron Mountain High School. She attended Bethel College in St. Paul, Minnesota and received her RN Degree from Mounds-Midway School of Nursing, also in St. Paul. Betty served as a missionary for 18 years in Tezpur, Assam, India, functioning as a nursing instructor in Tezpur's Baptist Christian Hospital. Betty returned to this country in 1968 and began work at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital in 1969. She worked on the Medical Floor until 1974, then as supervisor of infection control. She later worked in employee health and as medical librarian until retiring in 1986. Betty was a member of the Michigan Nurses Association. She was honored to be chosen First Lady of Dickinson County by the Beta Sigma Nu Sorority. Betty was a life-long member at Immanuel Baptist Church. She loved to study God's Word and to pray for missionaries around the world. She enjoyed poetry, wildflower walks at Fumee Lake Preserve, family genealogy, and cross stitch.

Betty was preceded in death by a brother, Earl Person. She is survived by a sister in-law, Norma Person of Iron Mountain; nieces, Phyllis (Clem) Fleury of Gladstone, and Sharon (Bruce) Olson of Norway; nephew, Gordon (Karen) Person of Iron Mountain; seven grand nieces and nephews; Special friends, Shirley Person and Beryl (Bob) Lee.
