Bonnie Kranz-Evosevich-Jones, 87, passed away on Wednesday, December 6, 2017 at Manor Care Health Services in Kingsford. Bonnie died one day after her 87th birthday. She was born on December 5, 1930 in Iron Mountain, MI, daughter of the late Francis and Dorothy (Dyer) Toutloff. Bonnie was a lifelong resident of the Dickinson County and graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1948. She married Norman Kranz in June of 1949 and he preceded her in death one year later in a tragic accident. Bonnie married Carl Evosevich in 1952 and he preceded her in death in 2002. She married Carl Jones in Iron Mountain and he also preceded her in death.

Bonnie took great pride in the many different jobs that she held throughout her life. Over the years she worked at Sears, Irish's Pub, the Dickinson Inn and the Iron Mountain Police Department as one of the first meter maids. For most of her working career, she was a secretary at the Iron Mountain Central School. She was active on civic boards and served on the Planning Commission. As a young mother, she was a cub scout leader and active in the Extension Group. Bonnie had a terrific green thumb and had a large garden for many years. She was often caught by her family snipping a shoot from a plant she like, no matter where it might be. Bonnie also loved playing cribbage, knitting and crocheting afghans for all the kids and grandchildren.
