Boyd was very creative so his vocation of stylist gave him a great outlet, as

well as blowing glass beads and making wind chimes. He always put a lot of thought into gifts for others and had a knack for the “perfect gift”. He could hardly wait to see people open their gifts and often would show up a couple weeks early and have you open it, because he couldn’t stand it.

Boyd was always true to himself and his honesty was refreshing. He had a sparkle in his deep brown eyes, a beautiful laugh, and an infectious smile. Many times he would surprise us with turquoise hair or a new tattoo or piercing. He enjoyed being unique. Boyd took a stand on labeling people and felt a person should be judged as an individual, not on appearance.

He loved animals with great tenderness and over the years had rescued and adopted many beautiful creatures.

Boyd was admired and loved, will never be forgotten, and is terribly missed already.
