Bruce T. Stuart, 91, of Kingsford, passed away on Saturday, February 22, 2020 at ManorCare Health Services in Kingsford.

Bruce was born April 17, 1928 in Ironwood, MI, son of the late Theodore and Nell (May) Stuart. He graduated from Kingsford High School in 1946 and was a lifelong resident of the area. Bruce married Julia Simons on Nov. 6, 1948, at Our Saviour's Lutheran Church in Iron Mountain. She preceded him in death on Sept. 16, 2004. Bruce was a piano tuner and pipe organ service man, working on most of the concert pianos in the central and western Upper Peninsula as well as at Northern Michigan University. Locally he installed pipe organs at the First Lutheran Church, Our Saviours Lutheran Church, St. Mary & St. Joseph Catholic Church and the Carmelite Monastery. He was a lifelong member of Holy Trinity Episcopal Church in Iron Mountain where he sang in the choir and served as a lector. He was also a member of the Golden K & Golden Throats since 1995 where he served as president several times. Bruce spent over 25 winters in Ruskin, FL, where he still has many friends. He enjoyed camping, playing cribbage, fishing and spending time with family and friends.

He is survived by two daughters, Candy (Bill) Buchcuski of Iron Mountain and Norma (Paul) Raboin of Norway; two sons-in-law, Doug Edlund of Aurora, WI and John Berquist of Merriman; 10 grandchildren, Kathy (Scott) Doda, Doug
