Carla Ann Winkler, 65 of Breitung Township passed away on Monday, April 1, 2013 at her home surrounded by family after a lengthy battle with brain cancer. She was born May 16, 1947 in Rhinelander, Wisconsin, daughter of Valeria (Denton) and the late Robert Rhode. She attended school in Rhinelander, graduating from Rhinelander High School.
