



## Carol Ann Brown Tokoly

October 14, 1937 - January 4, 2024

Carol Ann (Wahlstrom) Brown Tokoly, age 86, passed away on Thursday, Jan. 4, 2024, at Marshfield Medical Center - Dickinson, due to MDS, with her loving family by her side.

Carol was born in Iron Mountain, Michigan, on October 14, 1937, to Leonard and Maureen (Davis) Wahlstrom.
