Carol J. (Oliva) Kubick, 82 passed away peacefully and with her children by her side on Sunday, April 7, 2024.

She was a lifelong resident of Iron Mountain, MI, graduating from IMHS in 1960. She then went on to obtain her registered nursing diploma beginning at North Park College in Chicago and ending at Augustana Hospital's School of Nursing in 1965. 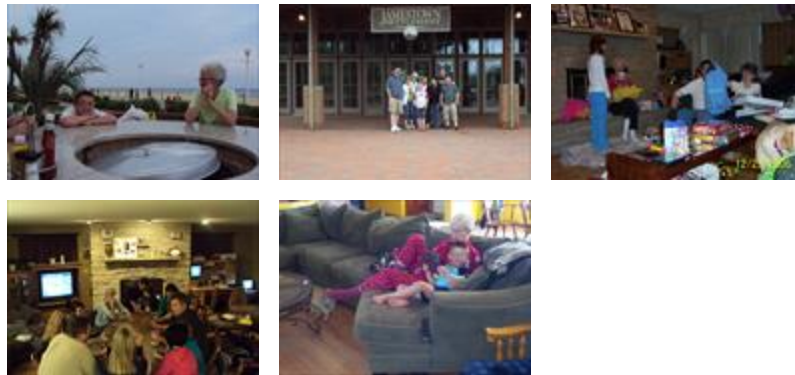
