Catherine A. Roell, 48, of Channing, died Tuesday Feb. 27, 2007 as a result of an automobile accident. She was born on Sept. 1, 1958 in Parkersburg, WV, the daughter of Margie (Robinson) Wilson and the late Robert Wilson, Sr.

Cathy moved to Iron Mountain with her family as a child. She graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1976 and then moved to Sawyer Lake.

She married Kenneth J. Roell on Nov. 10, 1979 at St. Rose Catholic Church in Channing.

Cathy was a RN for Dr. James Batti. She was a devoted mother who lived for her children. Cathy enjoyed cross country skiing, walking, and biking.
