



## Charles "Chuck" Elliott

July 13, 1934 - October 4, 2016

Charles "Chuck" David Elliott, 82, of Kingsford, passed away on Tuesday, October 4, 2016 at Maryhill Manor in Niagara.

Chuck was born on July 13, 1934 in Kingsford, son of the late Homer and Cecelia (Roth) Elliott. He graduated from Kingsford High School in 1953 and later enlisted in the United States Army, where he was honorably discharged in 1963. Chuck married Jean Wesoloski on February 10, 1962 in Menominee.

Chuck retired from the United States Postal Service in 1994, as well as wearing many hats from building, roofing, and home repairs. Often referred to as a "MacGyver" due to his uncanny ability to repurpose stuff, he took great pride in helping family, friends, and neighbors. He taught his children to appreciate the outdoors, to be hard workers, and to value friendships. Chuck enjoyed golfing, bowling, hunting, fishing, and playing horseshoes, billiards, bocce ball, smear and cribbage.

Chuck is survived by his son, David Elliott of Florida; three daughters, Suze (Paul) Markham of Maryland, Cindy (Scott) Aderman of Kingsford and Heidi (Joe) Rizzo of Kingsford; Grandchildren, Eric (Ashlynn) Aderman and Lucca and Ella Rizzo; and one Great Granddaughter, Gracie Jean Aderman. He is also survived by his loving sisters; Jeanne Anderson, Rita Paupore and Lois (Harry) Miron along with many cousins, nieces, nephews and friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Homer and Cecelia Elliott; his sisters Fay Partlow and Patricia Spires; and his loving wife, Jean Elliott.

The visitation is scheduled Monday, October 17, 2016, from 9:00 am to 11:00 am at the Erickson-Rochon and Nash Funeral Home in Iron Mountain.
