Charles W. Marcinek, 83, of Kingsford, died Sunday, July 11, 2010, at the Oscar G. Johnson V.A. Medical Center in Iron Mountain.

He was born on May 26, 1927, in Breitung Township, the son of the late Carl and Anna (Heczko) Marcinek. He graduated from Kingsford High School in 1945.

He enlisted in the U.S. Navy at the age of 17, with the permission of his parents. He served in the South Pacific with the SeaBees. After his honorable discharge he moved to Milwaukee and he graduated from Milwaukee Area Technical College.

He worked as a draftsman for the gas company while taking courses at Marquette University, where he received his engineering degree. He then worked at Bostrom until his retirement. He moved back to Kingsford in 1987 to care for his mother.
