At an early age, Charmaine knew she would always be a teacher, teaching school to her 'students' of dolls and stuffed bears. Always determined to achieve her goal, she received her teaching certificate from Marinette County Normal (teacher's college). She began her teaching career in Goodman Public Schools where she met her future husband, Bill. They were married June 1, 1956.

She was a Reading Specialist at Beecher/Dunbar/Pembine Schools from

1964 until her retirement in 1992. Each day she would make the journey along the back roads from Niagara to Pembine. Always wanting to further her own knowledge, she returned to college and earned her bachelor's degree in Education from Northern Michigan University in 1974.

Charmaine cared deeply for her students, but nothing meant more to her than family. She was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, aunt, cousin, and friend to everyone. (even if you weren't related by blood). She was always ready to raise a glass and cheer on her beloved Green Bay Packers.
