VULCAN - Chris J. Brodersen, 88, of W2240 Alfredson Road in Vulcan, died Saturday, June 6, 2009, at Pinecrest Medical Care Facility in Powers.

He was born July 6, 1920, in Escanaba, son of the late Jacob and Anna (Henricksen) Brodersen. Chris was a 1939 graduate of Felch High School. He served during World War II in the South Pacific with the United States Coast Guard.

He married Georgia Blackberg on June 28, 1947, at the Norway Swedish Methodist Church.

Chris worked as a truck driver for Clairmont Transfer for more than 30 years and retired in 1980. He has been a resident of this area his entire life. Chris was a member of the Evangelical Covenant Church in Norway. He was a gentle Christian man who loved the Lord and was never afraid to witness. Chris was very active in the churches he attended and served as a Sunday school teacher and various levels of church leadership.

He loved farming and raising cattle. Chris was a 4-H leader and has been an active volunteer at the Iron Mountain VA Medical Center since 1986. He was also a member of American Legion Post 340 in Hermansville. His hobbies included hunting and cutting wood.

He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Georgia; three sons, James (Janet) Brodersen of Marquette, David (Donna) Brodersen of Myrtle Beach, S.C. and Daniel (Cathy) Brodersen of Vulcan; his daughter-in-law, Marjorie Brodersen of Vulcan; seven grandchildren and four great-grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his son, John in 1995 and brothers, Jacob and Andrew Brodersen.

Visitation will be Wednesday from 9:30 a.m. to 11 a.m. at the Evangelical Covenant Church in Norway.

Funeral services will be Wednesday at 11 a.m. at the church. Rev. James Danielson will officiate.

Burial will be in the Quinnesec Cemetery.
