Christine J. St. Louis, 63, of Kingsford, passed away peacefully Sunday, February 12, 2023, at Aurora BayCare Medical Center in Green Bay, WI, surrounded by her loving family.

Chris was born July 31, 1959, in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Russel and Joyce (Anderson) Pultz. She graduated from Niagara High School in 1977 and went on to earn a degree as a Licensed Practical Nurse from Bay de Noc Community College. Chris took a position at Dickinson County Hospital as an LPN and continued her schooling at Bay, receiving her degree as a Registered Nurse. Chris married Thomas St. Louis on October 1, 1983, at St. Mary Queen of Peace Church in Kingsford. She worked as a nurse for Michigan-Wisconsin Family Practice for over 30 years, retiring in 2018.
