BREITUNG TOWNSHIP - Christopher K. Hogan, 48, of W6916 Upper Pine Creek Road in Breitung Township, died Friday, May 23, 2008, as the result of an accident while enjoying one of his favorite pastimes on the Lower Peavey Reservoir.

He was born on Jan. 2, 1960, in Rochelle, Ill., and is the son of Kenneth Hogan and the late Della (Wierschke) Hogan.

Chris married the former Jean Wender on June 3, 1995, at Our Redeemer Lutheran Church in Kingsford. He had worked several jobs including farming and meat packing. His real passion was in trucking and started at a young age while traveling over the road with his brother Terry. Chris has spent the last 25 years driving truck and was employed by Roehl Transport. He had received numerous driving awards including driver of the year at Roehl Transport.

Chris was a member of Our Redeemer Lutheran Church. He loved sports, especially the Pittsburgh Steelers. Chris was an avid outdoorsman and enjoyed camping, fishing, snowshoeing, gardening and walking in the woods.

He also loved riding in the fresh air on his Harley-Davidson. He is remembered best by his family as a loving man, wonderful husband and fun uncle who especially loved teasing his nieces and nephews and making them

laugh.
