Clarence W. Lindeman

89, of Niagara, passed away on April 24, 2017 at Maryhill Manor in Niagara. Clarence was born June 29, 1927 in Norway, MI, son of the late Arthur and Catherine (Zaharek) Lindeman. Clarence attended Norway Schools and entered the United States Navy in 1945. He served aboard the USS Piedmont during the end of WWII in the American occupation of Japan. Clarence was honorably discharged in 1949. After returning home from his service, Clarence married Dorothy Hover on May 6, 1950 in Iron Mountain. They raised their family together in Niagara and would have celebrated sixty seven years of marriage this year. Clarence worked over 43 years for Niagara of Wisconsin (NOW) paper company. He retired in 1987 as a maintenance supervisor. Clarence was also a certified welding instructor and taught welding for Northeast Wisconsin Technical College (NWTC) in the evenings for many years.

He was a talented handyman and had a special knack for machine repair. Clarence also loved to work on cars and help his family with building projects and home construction. His greatest love was time spent with his children and grandchildren.
