Corrine P. Munn, 85, of Kingsford, MI, died Wednesday, December 13, 2017 at Bellin Hospital in Green Bay, WI. She was born April 24, 1932 in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Hugo and Nina (Spigarelli) Bafile. She was a lifelong resident of the Iron Mountain/Kingsford area, graduating from the Iron Mountain High School in 1949.
