Aurora - Corrine "Corky" Palmcook, 75, of Aurora, WI, died Wednesday, December 30, 2009 at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital with her family at her side. She was born March 12, 1934 in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Edward and Judith (Vicenzi) Meagher.

Corky was a lifelong resident of this area and graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1951. She married Rodger Palmcook on May 10, 1958 at St. Mary & St. Joseph Church in Iron Mountain. She was a member longtime member of Sacred Heart Church in Aurora, the Christian Mothers, and the Knights of Columbus Auxiliary. Corky had a spunky and sassy personality, and a "wicked" sense of humor. She loved to tell a good story or joke and often times she could barely finish a joke because she was laughing so hard at the upcoming punch line. She and Rodger loved to travel and had been to every state except Hawaii, Louisiana, and Mississippi. She was especially good at crossword puzzles and games, and she loved to play cards with her friends. Corky's grandsons were the center of her life and she loved them very much. She always had a positive attitude and encouraged others no matter how things looked. During her illness, she applied that same positive attitude to her own life and was grateful for everyday she was given.

She is survived by her husband, Rodger; one son, Daniel (Noreen) Palmcook of Roseburg, Oregon; one daughter, Judy (Jim) Carncross of Green Bay;

three grandsons Michael, Nicholas, and Brian Carncross all of Green Bay, two sisters Germain Schroeder of Escanaba and Mickey Schultz of Iron Mountain, one brother Teddy (Pat) Meagher of Iron Mountain, and many nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by two infant sons, Scott and Dennis Palmcook.
