PEMBINE, Wis. - Cory L. Ehlert, 31, of Pembine, died Monday, Sept. 4, 2006, in Pembine.

He was born on Jan. 22, 1975, in Green Bay, Wis.

Cory graduated from Pembine High School. During high school he was a top master in the state for mathematics. He graduated with honors from Fox Valley Technical College in hydraulics-fluid power maintenance. Cory worked at ISP. For four years, he sponsored a Pembine Little League Baseball team, and he also sponsored the Tiger Trap Team.

He is survived by two daughters, Cortney and Kyler Ehlert; one son, Ryan Ehlert; his mother, Yvonne Leslie of Dunbar; his father, Kerry (Kris) Ehlert of Pembine; one brother, Codey Ehlert of Pembine; one sister, Heather (Andrew) Schiefelbein of Dunbar; his extended family, sister, Kayla Conley of Iron Mountain; brothers, Kevin and Aaron Rowling, both of Beecher, Wis.; his maternal grandmother, Gertrude Leslie of Iron Mountain; his paternal grandmother, Lorraine Ehlert of Dunbar; and many aunts, uncles, cousins and friends.
