Cory J. LaCount, 39 of Crystal Falls passed away unexpectedly at Marquette General Hospital on August 18, 2017.

Wish we could have reconnected more later in life. Miss you, Cory.

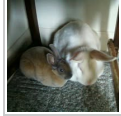

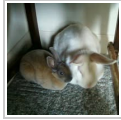
