Craig P. Sauld of Pembine passed away on Friday, Oct. 28, 2022, at the Oscar G. Johnson VA Medical Center at the age of 88.

He was born in Racine, WI, on March 22, 1934, to the late Leo and Emily (Certor) Sauld. Craig graduated from Horlick High School in 1952. Following graduation he enlisted with the Navy Reserves, serving for 8 years. On June 16, 1956, Craig was married to Sharon Jean (McDonald) Sauld in Racine, sharing 66 years together. Together they spent about 30 years on Lake Wisconsin near Lodi raising their family. Craig worked in sales for S. C. Johnson for about 30 years before retiring and later moving to Pembine.
