IRON MOUNTAIN - Daniel K. Bennett, 24, of 412 East C St., Iron Mountain, died Thursday, June 5, 2003, at his home.

He was born Jan. 31, 1979 in Oxford, Ohio. He and his family have been residents of Iron Mountain for the past nine years. Dan was a 1997 graduate of Iron Mountain High School.
