Daniel J. Oberdorfer, 62, of Kingsford, MI, passed away on Sunday, December 9, 2018.

He was born February 10, 1956 in Iron Mountain, MI, the son of Maxine (Urban) Oberdorfer and the late Robert Oberdorfer. Dan graduated from Kingsford High School in 1974 and was a lifelong resident of the area. He married Lauri Brackett on December 11, 1976 at American Martyrs Catholic Church in Kingsford. Dan was employed at the Niagara Paper Mill, retiring as a mill manager after 32 years. During that time, he also spent several years working as needed for the Dickinson County Sheriff's Dept as a transporter. Dan was a member of the Sons of the American Legion and volunteered many hours in helping construct the U.P. Veterans Memorial at Pine Mountain. He was an excellent cook and enjoyed making homemade sauerkraut, sausage, wine and maple syrup for his family and friends. Obe was a gentle giant who loved people and people loved him right back. He will be sadly missed by those who knew him.
