Darlene Lindstrom, 77, of Moon Lake, Breitung Township, passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, July 16, 2015 at Rennes Rehabilitation Center in Green Bay, Wisconsin, from injuries sustained in an automobile accident. The daughter of the late Frank and Dorothy (Peebles) Oien, she was born May 30, 1938 in Kingsford.

Darlene was a 1957 graduate of Kingsford High School. She married Kenneth "Shimo" Lindstrom on June 25, 1960 at Saint Mary and Saint Joseph Church in Iron Mountain by Monsignor Pelissier.

Children with special needs held a place in Darlene's heart; she was employed in special education with the Dickinson-Iron Intermediate School District until her retirement in 2001. 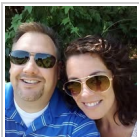
